Subject: Call for Volunteers for Sept East Coast Holiday

Hello All!

We are gearing up for the 356 Registry East Coast Holiday 2009 and this is our first call for volunteers!

Each and every one of you have told one of the committee members that you would be glad to be of assistance this year!

We are asking you to sign up on our volunteer list, with whatever you think you can do.

We know that this will be a FANTASTIC weekend, we just need a little assistance.

Below is a little description of what each "station" would be doing, so you will have an idea of what type of work will be expected of you. Don't hesitate to contact me with additional questions.

Thank you in advance for your assistance!

Registration: This will be checking in members as they arrive. Making sure their paperwork is in order, give them their "Goodie Bag", which will already be put together with their lanyards, shirts, etc.

There will be some specific instructions to give to each member. We plan to have 2 - 4 people at the desk at all times, so there will be breaks, etc, but you will be sitting for the majority of this task.

Hospitality Suite: This will be making sure all the food and beverages stay stocked for your 4 hour period. You do not have to stay in the Hospitality Suite the entire time you are "on the clock", unless you want to. Simply make sure that food and beverages are stocked, so check back often. You will be required to carry food and beverages in from the storage area.

Concours Signs and setup: You will be assisting our Concours Director with placement of signs around the grounds. This will be quite a bit of walking and putting metal yard signs (or something similar) in the ground in preparation for the Concours.

Concours Direction for parking: This team will be assisting our Concours Director with getting the cars from the hotel parking lot, onto the grounds, directing different classes of cars to their respective area. It would be best if you can distinguish different classes of cars on sight. This will be standing the entire time and speaking quite a bit to the drivers of the vehicles.

Poker Run/Scenic Drive: We have not narrowed down if this will be a poker run, or a scenic drive. Either way, we will need people to help direct cars to a starting point. Hand out additional maps if necessary (which will be at the Registration Table). If we do a poker run, we will need people at various stages throughout the run, to hand out the cards. This will be standing or sitting (if you bring a chair) for a few hours!
