NOTE #1: As consideration for being permitted to be a vendor at the Porsche Literature, Model, and Memorabilia Meet (“Lit Meet”), Vendor hereby agrees, on his/her behalf and on behalf of his/her assigns, heirs, distributees, guardians, and legal representatives, that Vendor will not make a claim against, sue, or attach the property of the organizers of the Lit Meet, their employees, agents, servants, or others who assist with the Lit Meet. This release applies to all successors and companies that are related in any way to the Lit Meet.

NOTE #2: Tables will be assigned. Tables are 2½' X 6' or larger. Earlier registrations will be in the primary International Ballroom; later registrations will be in the Pacific Ballroom directly across the hallway. Early-registering vendors who request placement by buddy(ies) who register late risk being assigned to Pacific.

NOTE #3: Free admittance to Vendor and **ONE helper per entrant**. Others will pay \$30 to enter the hall before 9 a.m. or \$10 to enter after 9 a.m. No

exceptions. No B.S., please. And please leave the kids home – it's better for them, you, and all the rest of us too.

NOTE #4: No smoking. No greasy or large car parts; small accessory items are okay. Food and drink available close by in the hotel.

NOTE #5: No ancillary tables or racks unless you arrange for the space for it in advance with Prescott, Jim or Wayne.

NOTE #6: Parking is available at the Hilton Hotel with valet parking at the front entrance or self park by driving to the alley on the west side of the hotel. There is another garage right next to the Hilton. Oversize vehicles/tall vans will not fit in Hilton lot, but will fit into the open lot one block to the west of the Hilton.

For vendors, please send \$80 per table advance registration fee to Wayne Callaway (checks payable to "2010 Lit Meet" and NOT Wayne, please). Tables will be \$125 each at the door. Please mail to arrive in Ontario, CA by Friday February 26th, 2010 – VERY LATEST – for the low rate. Otherwise there will be no alternative to paying \$125 at the door. Thanks.

27th Annual Porsche & Vintage VW Literature, Toy/Model, and Memorabilia Swap Meet – Los Angeles Airport Hilton Hotel

March 6th, 2010

Dear Enthusiast:

The 27th annual Literature, Toy/Model, and Memorabilia Meet for Porsches and Vintage VW's will be held again at the Los Angeles Airport Hilton on Century Boulevard close by L. A. International Airport. The meet will be on the same weekend as last year, Saturday, March 6th, 2010 and will avoid all known conflicts with the 24 Hours of Daytona, RetroMobil, 12 Hours of Sebring, the Super Bowl, etc.

For 2010 we are once again in the International and Pacific Ballrooms – behind Hilton Registration and the elevators on the **main level**. We will have room for about 180 well-spaced tables (wide aisles) in the International Ballroom and up to 75 more in Pacific.

The vendor table charge will be \$80 for all advance registrations (must be received in Ontario, CA by February 26th) and \$125 at the door. The hall will be open for set-up and vendor buying, selling, and swapping at 7:00a.m. Non-vendors will be able to enter the hall after 9:00 a.m. and will be charged \$10 per person at the door. "Early-bird" shoppers will be admitted with the vendors at 7:00 a.m. for \$30 per person at the door. Once again there will be no required pre-registration for Early-birds – just pay and walk in. The meet will end at 2:00 p.m. The entire meet will be non-smoking.

The Los Angeles Airport Hilton is at 5711 W. Century Blvd., and the phone number is 310-410-4000. Be certain to call the hotel directly and ask for the group code "PVW" rates when you make your reservations. The standard rooms will be \$114 on the "PVW" group code, the tower rooms will be \$139 (both king or two-doubles); and Executive Floors \$167 king only. Please remember that the hotel is close by Los Angeles International Airport and that it runs 24-hours-a-day shuttle buses to the airport.

Earlier registrations will get into the primary International Ballroom; later registrations will be in the adjacent Pacific Ballroom. NOTE: Some early registrants ask to be placed by other vendor(s). Sometimes those friends register late, or even very late, and go into the Pacific Ballroom. In that case we also place the early registrant in the Pacific ballroom to be with his buddy. **THAT IS A RISK YOU RUN WHEN YOU ASK TO BE PLACED WITH OTHER VENDORS**, if they register late. It is the only way to be fair to all other early registrants.

You can register with the form enclosed or download one from our website at www.LALitAndToyShow.com. We will email (only!) confirmations to all the registrants whose payment is received by Wayne Callaway in Ontario, CA by February 26th, 2010.

Please carefully read the "NOTES" on the Vendor Registration Form enclosed. They are an important part of our mutually agreed-to terms under which we invite you to participate in the Meet.

The SoCal All-Porsche Swap & Car Display will again be held on the day after the Lit Meet, Sunday, March 7th, once again at the Phoenix Club, 1340 South Sanderson, Anaheim, CA 92806, about a mile from the old Dunkel Brothers site. If you were there last year, you know it's a terrific site. See <http://www.thephoenixclub.com> for details on this German-American Club. As before, they will have the FestHalle of 11,500 feet under one roof, plus lots of outside room for more vendors and a large grass soccer field for car corrals. Gates open at 8am. As before, vendors will make a \$40 donation per space and car displayers a \$20 donation, with all proceeds going to an Orange County children's charity.
